All-Long Island Swimming and Diving Team

Guidelines:

1. There is no limit to the number of events for which a competitor may be selected.
2. Divers will be selected for both a dual meet (six dives) and a championship meet (eleven dives) format.
3. There is no limit to the number of competitors that may be selected for individual events from the same team.
4. All-Long Island Swimming and Diving Team members will be those swimmers who have the lowest submitted times and divers who have the highest point totals.

When submitting meter times, indicate both the meter time and the yard conversion time. (i.e.. 50m. Free... 25.36sec. m. / 22.66sec. yd.) Note: $25.36 \times .8937 = 22.664232 = 22.66$; digits beyond 2 places are dropped. For other events, use the appropriate conversion factors provided on the application.
5. When a competitor's time is obtained via manual timing or semi-automatic timing, only the first place time submitted by the meet referee will be considered.
6. Applications for the All-Long Island Swimming and Diving Team will be distributed to coaches in Sections VIII and XI at the pre-season rules interpretation meeting. (forms may be duplicated)
7. The All-Long Island Swimming and Diving Team will be announced at the annual banquet of the LISOA.
8. All-Long Island Swimming and Diving records will be kept by the LISOA in conjunction with this format.
9. Each selected competitor and their respective High School will receive a certificate signifying their achievement.
10. An outstanding competitor award may, at the discretion of the LISOA, be awarded to one of the All-Long Island Swimming and Diving Team members. Criteria and selection for this award will be the sole responsibility of the LISOA selection committee.
11. A Coach-of-the-Year award may, at the discretion of the LISOA, be awarded to one

interscholastic swimming and/or diving coach actively coaching on Long Island during the 2005-2006 (winter) swimming season. Criteria and selection for this award will be the sole responsibility of the LISOA selection committee. Coaches are encouraged to submit their name and a resume to the selection committee for consideration.

Eligibility:

1. Any swimmer or diver competing during the 2005-2006(winter) interscholastic swimming season is eligible for selection
2. Competitors must compete for a high school that is an active member of either Section VIII or Section XI.
3. A maximum of three competitors will be selected for each individual event. (ties for any given place may dictate increasing this number ...in such cases, all qualified swimmers/divers would receive recognition)
4. Only one relay team per school per relay event may be selected.
5. Applications for selection to the All-Long Island Swimming and Diving Team must be submitted on a properly completed and signed entry form. Applications improperly completed and/or not received by the deadline as stated below, will not be accepted for consideration by the committee.*
*Results obtained at the New York State Intersectional Championships will be used by the selection committee and do not require an official application.
6. Only times and point totals obtained in a sanctioned meet will be eligible for consideration by the All-Long Island Swimming and Diving team selection committee.
7. Applications for the All-Long Island Swimming and Diving Team must be received by the selection committee no later than :
12:00 noon on Monday, March 6, 2006
